

SHOP MECHANIC

The City of Berlin, WI (population 5,552) is accepting applications for a Shop Mechanic within the Department of Public Works. The Shop Mechanic reports directly to the Street Superintendent.

The Shop Mechanic repairs and maintains equipment for the DPW, Oakwood Cemetery, Parks and Recreation, and Berlin Aquatic Center. The position also has responsibilities for other DPW duties as required including maintaining City street light system, inventory, plumbing, welding, fabricating, repairing curbing, catch basins, manholes, tree trimming and removal, leaf pick-up, snowplowing, etc.

Shop Mechanic's minimum education shall include a H.S. diploma and one-year diesel or auto mechanics course from an accredited vocational school. Ideal candidate will possess a two-year associate degree in auto technology. A minimum of one year experience as an auto mechanic, diesel mechanic or related field is required as well as experience in hydraulic repair. Residency within a 15-mile radius of Berlin City Hall and possession of a valid WI Driver's License and CDL is required.

This position is classified as a Grade 6 with a salary range of \$38,203-\$49,665. Starting depends on qualifications and experience level. Benefit package is excellent.
