A very special visit to historic Ephraim has been planned. A tour guide will share the interesting history of Ephraim, which includes The Anderson Store, Pioneer Schoolhouse, Goodletson Cabin and other points of interest in Ephraim.

We will be treated to “Door County’s Best Fish Boil” at the newly restored building that housed Ephraim’s post office in the early 1900’s, now known as the Old Post Office Restaurant. Learn the history of fish boils as we observe how it’s done. Note; if you’re not a fish lover we can call ahead and order chicken just for you.



We’re not done yet! Next we will head in the direction of home but with a stop at the Door Peninsula Winery for a fun time when we will take a free tour of the historic 1868 schoolhouse building. We will sample wines, spirits, oils & vinegars, beer, fudge, cherry salsa and other gourmet foods. Then shop the retail area full of wines, souvenirs, snacks and drinks before you go.
