

SPRING CLEANUP AND SCHEDULE FOR SERVICES FOR CITY OF BERLIN RESIDENTS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY AS SOME CHANGES HAVE BEEN MADE.

GRASS/LEAF PICKUP -- There will be a separate pickup for just leaves the week of **May 7, 2018**.

- The crew will only make **one swing** through the city, if leaves are not out by **7:00 a.m. May 7th**, you will have to make other arrangements to have them removed.
- Leaves will be composted. Consequently, keep the leaves “**clean**” do not mix twigs and other rubbish with them.

SPRING RUBBISH PICK-UP -- Will be held the week of **May 7, 2018**. **Please read the GENERAL INFORMATION section thoroughly.**

MONDAY, May 7, 2018	The area south of Broadway and west of the bridge.
TUESDAY, May 8, 2018	The area north of Broadway and west of the bridge.
WEDNESDAY, May 9, 2018	The area north of West Huron, east of the bridge and west of N. Wisconsin St.
THURSDAY, May 10, 2018	The area north of East Huron and east of North Wisconsin St.
FRIDAY, May 11, 2018	The area south of East Huron and east of the bridge.

GENERAL INFORMATION – In order to cut the volume of waste materials going into the landfill, please keep your rubbish separated. Please keep the following in mind when placing materials out for pick-up:

- The purpose of the pick-up is to allow residents to dispose of general household rubbish.
- **The City reserves the right to limit how much will be picked up. Please call ahead if you are unsure. (920-361-5425) Failure to comply will result in your materials not being picked up.**
- All materials must be at curbside by 7:00 A.M.
- Separate piles should be made for:

Bulky Waste	Metal items	Lumber and wood products	Appliances
Brush	Furniture	Demolition Waste	

- REFRIGERATORS, FREEZERS, DEHUMIDIFIERS, MICROWAVES, and AIR CONDITIONING UNITS will be picked up for a **\$6.00 fee** per appliance, which is due in advance, payable at the City Clerk’s Office.
- **Tires will not be picked up by the City.** You may dispose of your tires by taking them to Valley Trail Landfill.
- Televisions, computer monitors and fluorescent light ballasts are hazards and **will not** be picked up.
- Rubbish that is not separated **will not** be picked up.
- **DO NOT** deposit material in the street area – **KEEP** it in the terrace area.
- It is **unlawful** to dispose of materials from non-residents of the City of Berlin.

- Leaves will only be taken if bagged or boxed. (Please see Grass/ Leaf pick up above)

E-CYCLE DROP OFF: Sat. May 5th the City Garage will be open from 8:00 AM – 12:00 noon

DEADLINE FOR STUMP GRINDING WILL BE MAY 4TH COST WILL BE \$75.00 FOR TERRACE TREES

BRUSH PICKUP -- You can help us improve efficiency if you follow these guidelines:

- Pile your brush neatly with all the cut ends facing the same direction.
- Pile a long, low pile rather than heaping it up.
- **Do not** mix small twigs, leaves, or garden vines with brush.
- This will be the only brush pick up through the year. Residents will be responsible for disposal of brush cut any other time of year.

HAZARDOUS WASTE -- Hazard waste materials, paints, pesticides, herbicides, etc. **will not** be picked up.

SUMMER CURBSIDE PICK-UP

The Tuesday morning pickup for grass clippings, leaves, and brush disposal is limited, please follow the guidelines listed below.

- This pick-up is intended for the elderly and physically challenged.
- This will begin May 8th, 2018.
- This is limited to grass clippings, which must be in containers or bags that can be easily handled.
- This is limited to brush and branches of amounts that can be handled by hand without the use of equipment.

To have materials picked up:

- Call the City Garage at 361-5425 on Mondays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 3:30 p.m.
- **DO NOT** call City Hall.
- Materials will be picked up on Tuesdays starting at 6:00 a.m.
- Failure to comply with conditions will result in the materials not being picked up.

Drop-off at the City Garage will be the first Saturday of every month, May through October.

- Will start on May 5th, 2018. The garage will be open between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon.
- Large piles of brush may be disposed of by calling the Public Works Department at 361-5425 Monday thru Friday between the hours of 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. to request a public works truck.
- There is a fee of **\$20.00** for the first truckload and \$10.00 for additional loads on that same day. The fee must be paid at the City Clerk's office prior to delivery of the truck.

FALL LEAF COLLECTION WILL BEGIN THE SECOND WEEK IN October.
